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9 Listed Dead In Accidents

A batch of drownings and high-way mishaps dominated New Jersey's weekend accident list and left nine persons dead throughout the State today.

Traffic accidents and drownings each accounted for four fatalities. One other death was attributed to heat stroke. In addition, two other Jersey residents died in out-of-State mishaps.

Robert Conklin, 33, died of a fractured skull and internal injuries last night at the Jersey City Medical Center after falling from a truck on which he was returning from a picnic.

John A. Miller, 58, of Newport, Wilmington, Del., was the heat stroke victim, Atlantic County Physician I. E. Leonard said. Miller's body was found in a beached rowboat at Ventnor yesterday.

Two-year-old Maureen McCartney of Lakehurst was the youngest victim. She was injured fatally yesterday when she was run over by a truck.

Mrs. Dorothy Ellmer, 53, Newark, was killed yesterday when a car in which she as riding was in a collision.

Morgan Lucas, 19, Bernardsville, was injured fatally Saturday when he was thrown from an automobile when the vehicle struck a pole in Madison.

Clarence Monroe, 55, South Port Norris, drowned Saturday when he fell into Delaware Bay from an oyster boat or which he was employed as a deckhand.

Carl C. Lepper, 48, Keyport, drowned yesterday while on a fishing trip alone in Raritan Bay.

Robert Fiorini, 14, Philadelphia, drowned yesterday while attending a picnic at a lake near Clementon.

Robert Jalardi, 26, New York City, drowned yesterday during an outing at Farrington Lake, Milltown.

In out-of-State accidents, Calvin Huntoon, 17, East Orange, was killed Saturday when a gun accidentally discharged while he and a companion were shooting crows near the seashore at South Bristol, Me.
